A new Archbishop of Sydney

The Very Rev'd Kanishka Raffel, currently serving as Dean in St Andrew's Cathedral, Sydney has been elected as the next Archbishop of Sydney. On 28 May, he will be officially installed making him the spiritual leader of some half a million people who identify as Anglicans in the Greater Sydney and Wollongong areas.

Kanishka has been married to Cailey for 32 years, and they have two adult daughters. Born in London of Sri Lankan parents, Kanishka arrived in Australia as a 7 year old. His father died soon after and his mother and siblings moved back to Sri Lanka for a couple of years before returning when Kanishka was 9 years old.

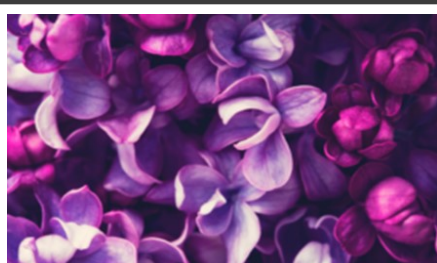
Raised a Buddhist, a friend gave Kanishka a copy of two Gospels when he was at University. At the age of 21, Kanishka was convicted by the inescapable words of Jesus in John's Gospel: 'No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day'

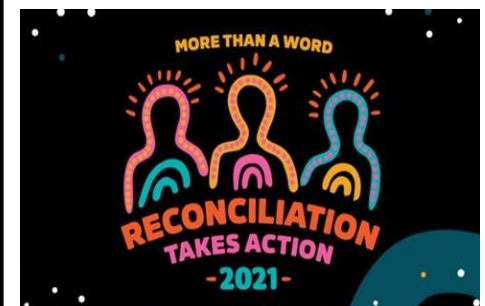
