## ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday is a day of special solemnity. It is a day on which the voice of God speaks, and calls us to listen. It is a day of reckoning at the beginning of Lent, the great forty days, which makes up the season of reckoning. They are days of pilgrimage in which we make the journey to the celebration of Easter.

"Lent" means "spring", and when the season comes, it is the time when growth begins, and fresh new life forces its way out of that which seemed to be dead.

In this cycle of nature, there is a lesson for human living. People also need to withdraw, to take account of themselves, if their lives are to be reshaped and they are to grow and mature.

Christians do this in Lent, and in the mystery of Easter they celebrate their discovery of new life - new life styles, fresh attitudes and deeper personal insights - which are born from all serious reckoning.

The celebration on Ash Wednesday therefore sets the scene for the next six weeks. God calls us to penitence, and the solemnity comes from our recognition that we stand under God's judgment.

May our prayer be for a holy and attentive Lent in preparation for Easter, when the Church celebrates its annual renewal in the death and resurrection of Christ.
