"He shall be to you a restorer of life and a nourisher of your old age." ([Ruth 4.15](#))

"He shall be to you a restorer of life."

As a youngster I learnt to place all my trust in God for my health. By middle age I felt despair when I was faced with one of my life's biggest challenges, as I discovered that I had suffered from gender dysphoria since early childhood. I could never get my head around people telling me that I was a girl when I knew I was a boy from the age of two. It is now in my retirement years that I have discovered God nourishing my life in a most wondrous and unforeseen way.

Through God's grace, my life has been restored in my older age – in part through my transition. Previously I was surviving. Now, I feel like I am really living life for the very first time. God has always known who I am on the inside.


Because I have lived much of my life on the margins, I have had to observe and listen more than I would have otherwise. My journey has taught me that everyone has a lived life story. People who observe and listen from the periphery develop compassion for those who struggle and are able to offer unique insights.

Our God is a God of restoration and nourishment who wants us to nourish others through love and compassion.
